## WHAT IS CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD?

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is Christian formation for children ages 3 -12 which begins with the acknowledgement that God already has a special relationship with the child. In the Children's Chapel, the adult works to create a sacred environment which meets the developmental needs of the child and fosters the child's personal relationship with the Good Shepherd. This is done through the proclamation of Scripture, prayer, and the mystery of the sacraments (particularly Eucharist & Baptism). Influenced by the research of Maria Montessori, the St Matthias program places an emphasis on the shared Christian life in which adults and children together listen to Christ as the true teacher in Word and sacrament.



"The sheep hear his voice, as he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.
When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice." John 10:3b-4







Gently we unwrap the pieces of the creche and place them carefully on the table. The children delight in seeing their favorite figure, be it an angel, the shepherds or one of the sheep and long to hold it in their own hands as they ponder the story in their minds and hearts.




## THE CHILDREN'S CHAPEL

The Children's Chapel will allow the child the space to draw closer to God. It is a place where the child can listen to the proclamations of the Good News from the Word of God; meditate on the Word of God and begin to live it according to the child's own rhythm.

It is a place for the announcement of the Word of God, a place for

celebration and also a place for work. It is an environment in which work becomes meditation and prayer. The child's expression of the religious life is manifested through prayer responses whether silent or aloud, in contemplation, and through artwork.
